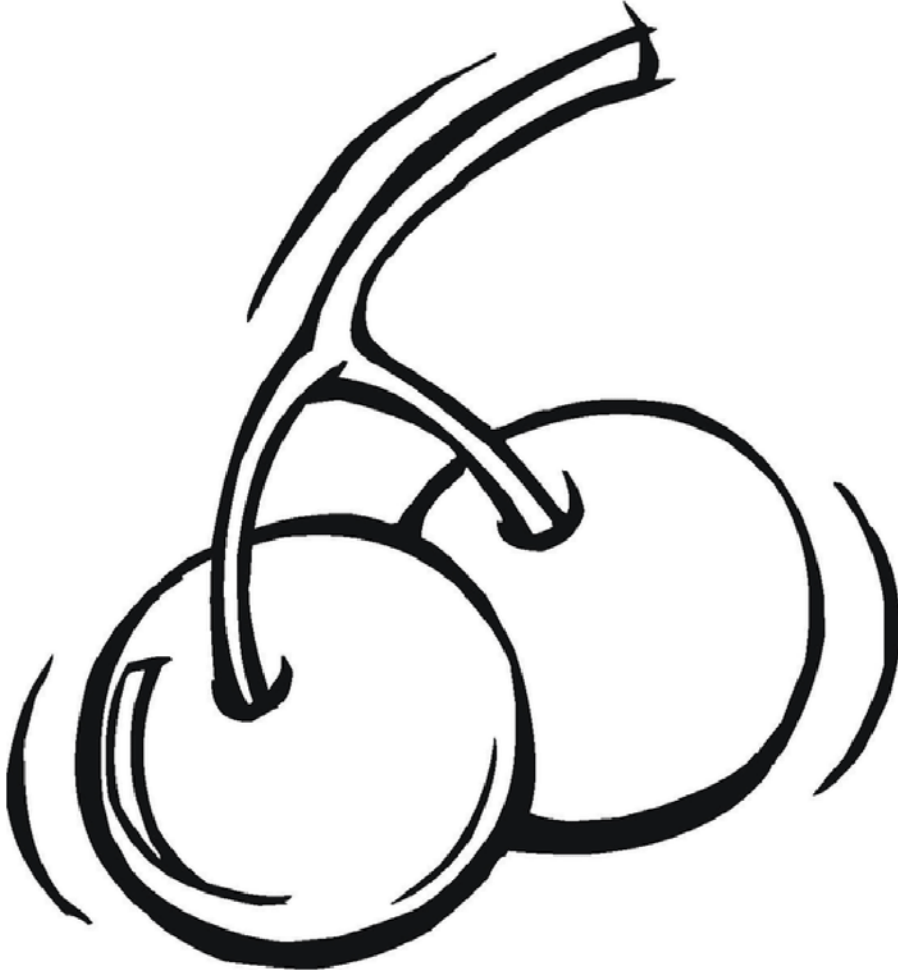

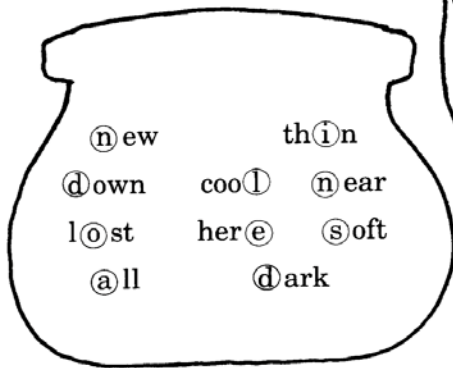
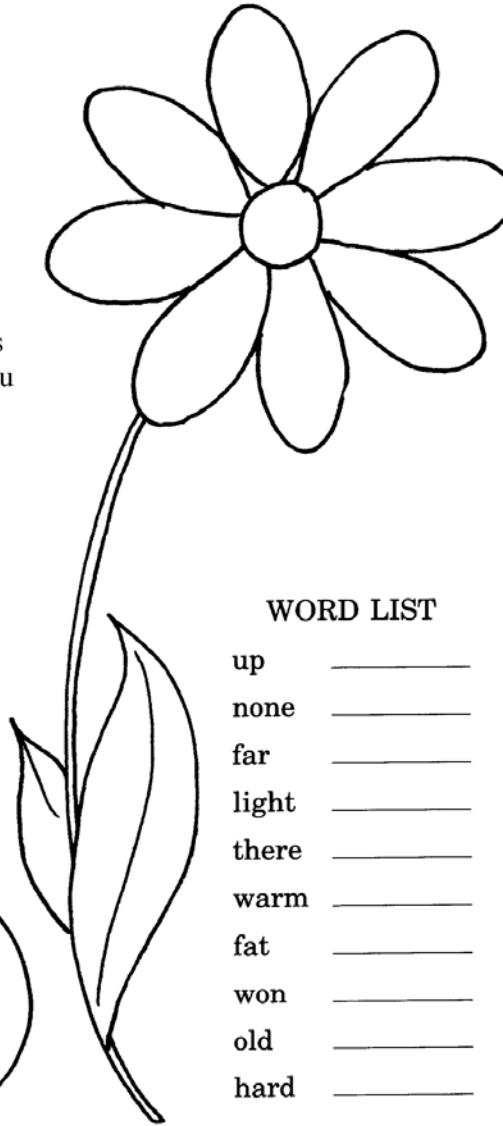
Picking cherries is fun!

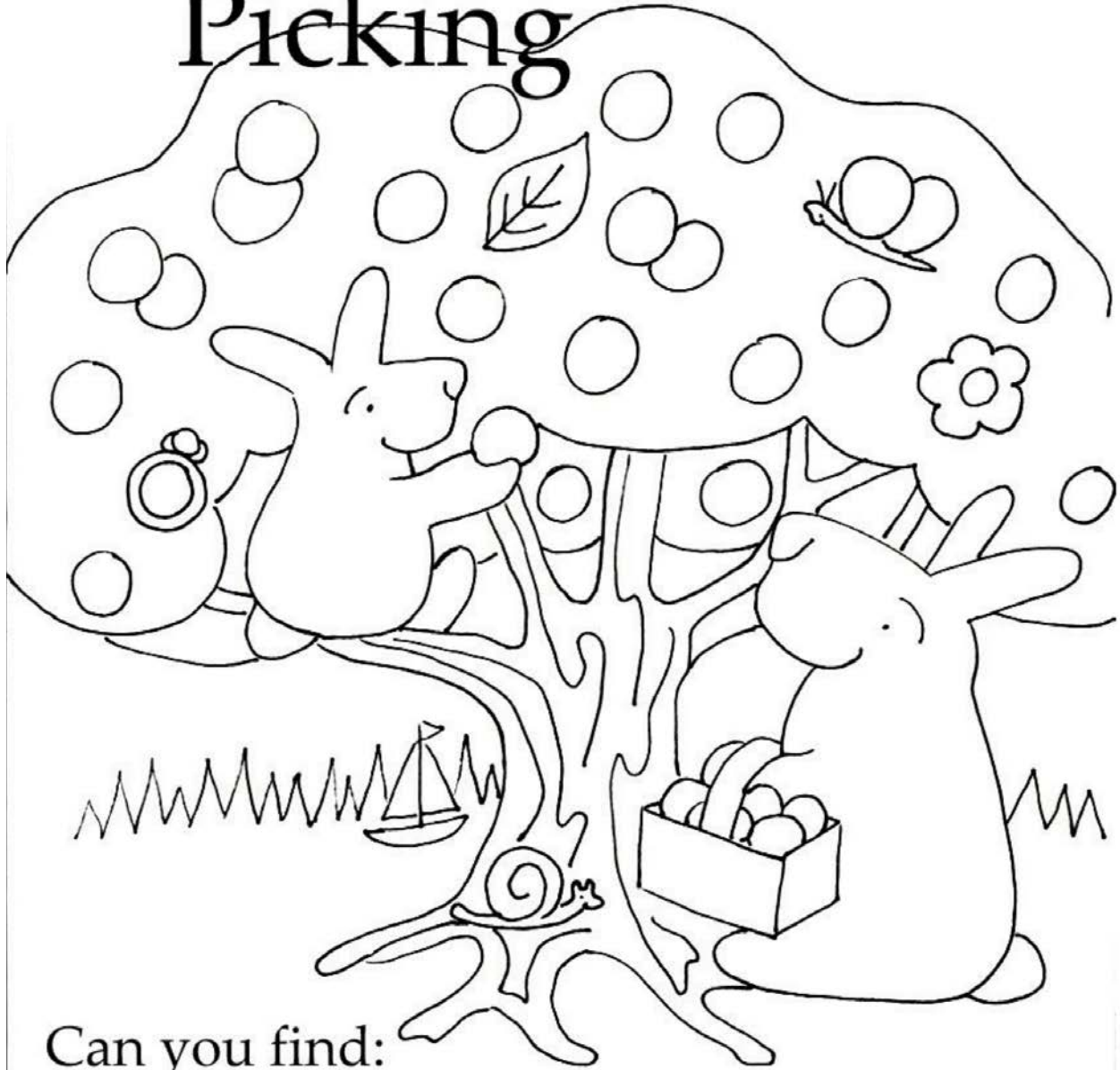

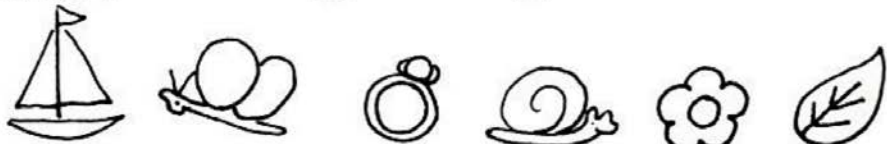
